Student Identification Policy

The purpose of this policy is to ensure safety and security of students in the Uniontown Area School District as well as providing accessibility for students to many school functions.

Student identification (ID) cards will be provided to every student annually in the Uniontown Area School District. One ID card will be issued at no charge to the student. A fee of \$5.00 will be charged to re-issue lost cards.

All students are required to carry a valid school identification (ID) card that can be readily presented upon request by school personnel during the school day. School ID cards may be used for admittance to school sponsored events such as dances, checking out library books, purchasing breakfast/lunch in the cafeteria.

Students in grades 7-12 will gain free admission into Uniontown Area High School football games when presenting their ID card. Students may receive a ticket for boys and girls high school basketball games (except for the Laurel Highlands game as limited seating is available.) There will be no free tickets issued for any playoff games.
