| Suicide Awareness Act 171 (for teachers in grades 6-12) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On June 26, 2014, Act 171 was signed into law in Pennsylvania. This law specifically requires school entities to provide 4 hours of professional development every 5 years in youth suicide awareness and prevention for professional educators in buildings serving students in grades 6-12. In order to satisfy this requirement, professional educators in buildings serving any students in grades 6-12 need to ANNUALLY complete the 52 minute online course on Safe Schools.
