- **How to Log In/Orientation Video**
 - Open Chrome on your child's iPad
 - Go to: <https://sislogin.edgenuity.com/>
 - Watch the orientation video on the login page
 - Username: firstname.lastname@uasdraiders.org
 - Password: School ID number (7 digits, starts with "20", also called students' lunch number)
- **Additional parent information:**
 - Students in grades 6-8 will have the following courses Language Arts, Math or Algebra, Science, Social Studies, Health Quest, and Keyboarding/Computer Applications
 - Students in grades 9-12 will have courses based on their grade level, career path and elective choices.
 - Attendance policy for cyber students to follow.
 - Students will continue to receive UASD report cards, with the following grading scale:
93-100% A, 85-92% B, 75-84% C, 67-74% D, Below 67% F

- **Information about Grades:** There are 3 types of grades often used in Edgenuity. Please pay attention to which grade you are looking at when determining if you are passing or failing the whole course.
 - **Actual Grade:** This metric displays a weighted average of the student's submitted activities while also incorporating a progress penalty if the student is behind the suggested pacing for the course.
 - **Overall grade:** This is the average grade of only the work that has been submitted to date, not all the work for the course. Students may have a high overall grade but could still be missing work for the whole course.
 - **Relative Grade:** This is computed by assigning zeros for all activities a student has not yet completed in the course. It reflects an estimate of the student's final course grade if he or she were to discontinue work in the course today.
- **Lunch Pick-Up Process for Cyber Students:**
 - The Uniontown Area School District will provide a five day bundle of breakfast and lunch meals for district students enrolled in cyber instruction. Due to the expiration of USDA waivers, for

the 2021 - 2022 school year, we are only permitted to serve meals to students enrolled in UASD or in UASD cyber on instructional days. The meal bundles may be picked up on Mondays from 10:00-10:45. If there is no school on a Monday, distribution would resume on the first day of instruction for the week. You must call in to pick up location cafeteria listed below by 9:00AM to reserve your bundle. No orders will be accepted after 9:00AM. Please give the name of the UASD student when placing your order. In order to provide meals for our cafeteria students as well, we cannot distribute cyber meals without your reservation.

- Cyber students enrolled in Wharton, Marclay or AJ Mc Mullen will pick up meals from **Wharton Elementary**, 724-329-5510
- Cyber students enrolled in Senior High School, Lafayette, or Ben Franklin will pick up from **Senior High School**, 724-430-5000
- Cyber students enrolled in Menallan or Franklin will pick up from **Menallan Elementary**, 724-438-4160
